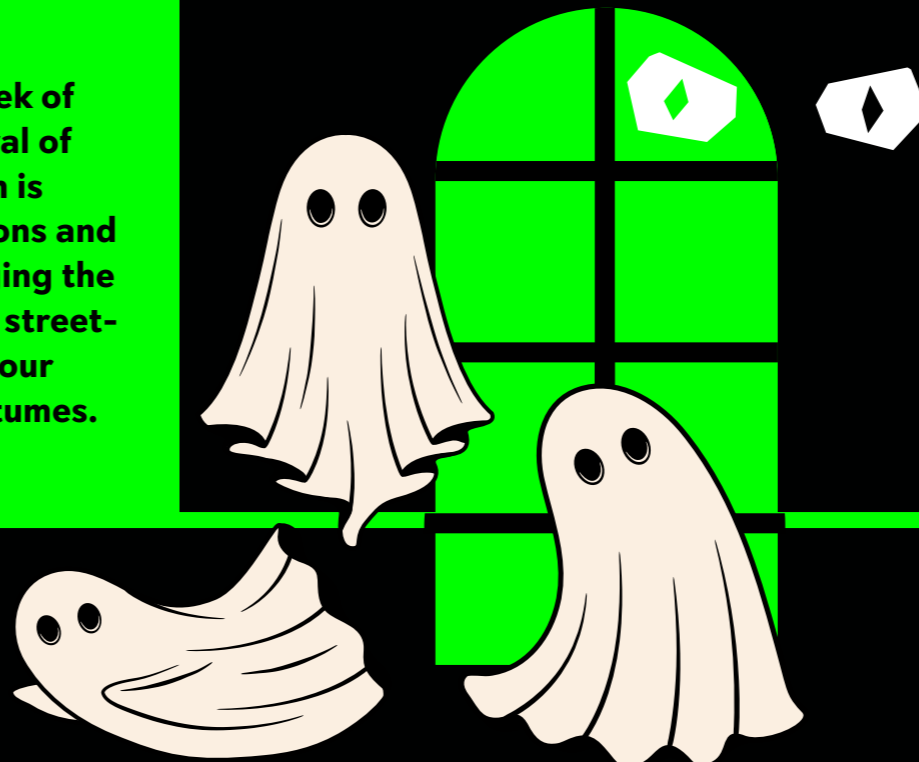
KENSINGTON GOES BOO! THIS HALLOWEEN

KENSINGTON'S GHOST STORIES

Holland House, built in 1605 by Sir Walter Cope, is said to be haunted by Henry Rich, the 1st Earl of Holland, who roams the ruins carrying his severed head under his arm.

The Tower House on Melbury Road, now owned by rock legend Jimmy Page, was once reported by former owner, Harry Potter actor Richard Harris, to be haunted by the ghosts of children from an orphanage that once stood on the site.

Even Kensington Palace has its spectres, with three reported ghosts including Princess Sophia, Queen Victoria's aunt and George II. The nursery is said to be haunted by 'Peter the Wild Boy,' a feral child brought from Hanover by King George I, who lived in the woods and walked on all fours.
